## FROM PASTOR DAVE'S PEN

**Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1**

*Faith through the years has been described with words like believe and trust. The letters of the word have been used in writing the description: For-saking All I Trust Him. The him being God. Where trusting and believing are indicative of a relationship; in this case the relationship between God and people. What makes this relationship unique is that it begins with, is sustained by and has God at its center.*

*As we live and continue to grow into this relationship as the people of God, there are some features that are unique to this to it. During the season of Lent the community will look at five of those features on Wednesday evenings as congregations gather for worship and fellowship. The theme for this year's observance is Faith and Life. While Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 9, the community's gather in worship and fellowship around this theme will be happening on the five Wednesday evenings between Ash Wednesday and Holy Week. The schedule for these weeks is as follows.*

*This observance of Lent begins on Ash*



*Wednesday, March 9, at 7:00 pm with Our Savior's, Melo, 1<sup>st</sup> Lutheran and Immanuel coming together for a service that will include the imposition of ashes and Holy Communion. Our Savior's will be the host for that service.*

*The observance will conclude with the services during Holy Week. These include the Maundy Thursday on Wednesday, April 20, at 7:00 pm at Melo; the Maundy Thursday worship on April 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 pm at Our Savior's and the service on Good Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 7:00 pm at 1<sup>st</sup> Lutheran. The Good Friday service also is a coming together of the Our Savior's, Melo, 1<sup>st</sup> and Immanuel Lutheran churches.*

*A part of the faith expression that has become a part of the season of Lent especially is the gathering of different non-perishable food items on Sunday mornings for the food shelf to compliment the monetary gifts received on Wednesday evenings. Last year I introduced a guide for the gathering of the different food items that some found helpful. This year I am doing the same. The following list only a guide. You are welcome to bring any of the physical items for the food shelf as you are able.*

Minutes from December 20, 2010, council meeting was reviewed. Motion Accepted Approved (MSA).

**Pastors Report:**

- Attended the Warren Food Shelf annual meeting. Items to note: each congregation in the service area is entitled to one member and the pastor on the board that oversees the food shelf. The service area for the Warren Food Shelf is Oslo, Alvarado, Warren and Viking. The month of March is Foodshare month in the state of Minnesota.
- Attended the Pathways Board meeting. The annual meeting for Pathways is Sunday, March 6, at Concordia Lutheran Church in Fertile beginning at 2 pm. Melo and Our Saviors are each entitled to one voting representative at the meeting.
- The Re-Rooting event has been rescheduled for Saturday, March 5 at Mount St. Benedict in Crookston. The time frame for the event has been made more compact with the goals and objectives remaining the same as the original flyer presented them.
- Visitation – 9 home visits, 8 included communion, 3 hospital visits, 2 nursing home visits.
- In addition, the Pastor took two personal days to care for sick parents during which time the Warren Ministerial met. Plans are taking shape for the upcoming season of Lent.
- February 20-27 Pastor Dave and Rena will be taking a vacation to Orlando.

**Oral Communications**

Dean discussed that the council needs to be mindful of the Parsonage exempt status by the charging of rent etc... The majority of time the residence needs to be a parsonage for it to maintain its tax-exempt status

**Stewardship and Mission:**

Pastor mentioned that he has kept the ministerial group up to date on the sign issue. Nick noted that he would be getting the letter out this month.

**Worship and Evangelism:**

- It was decided that the welcome visitation of new families will continue, this will be done in May, September and December
- Continued enrichment of our own members was discussed and how to reach out
- The church has nice silk flower arrangements for all seasons other than winter; there is nothing for the pulpit unless a funeral has taken place. The committee would like to purchase some silk ferns.
- The servant groups are struggling to get people to serve. The committee has some ideas that will be presented at the annual meeting.
- Communion servers for February: 6 – Karen, Carol and Jason and the 20<sup>th</sup> – Ilene, Jim and Carol

The parsonage basement not completed
